#### Beherrschen von grundlegenden kommunikationsrelevanten Strukturen, z.B.:

- Zeiten/tenses (present tense, past tense, present perfect tense, past perfect tense jeweils simple and progressive, going-to-future, will-future) richtig bilden und verwenden (in Einsetzübungen oder Sätzen/Texten)
- richtige Bildung von Aussagesätzen, Fragesätzen und verneinten Sätzen
- modal verbs in den unterschiedlichen Zeiten richtig abwandeln und verwenden
- Satzstellung/ word order: Satzglieder in der richtigen Reihenfolge anordnen
- Adjektive und Adverben richtig bilden und verwenden

#### Hörverständnis:

- Verstehen von Unterrichtsanweisungen
- Verstehen von Hauptpunkten in einfachen Standarddialogen in Alltagssituationen
- Verstehen von vertrauten Themenbereichen in Interviews, Berichten oder Hörspielen (z.B.: Schule, Familie, Hobbies)

#### Sprechfähigkeit:

einfache Standarddialoge, Interviews, Telefonate und Rollenspiele zu vertrauten Themen beginnen, in Gang halten und beenden

#### Leseverständnis:

- Verstehen von Anweisungen und Aufgabenstellungen
- Verstehen von kurzen literarischen Texten (z.B.: Erzählungen, Lieder, Gedichte)
- Verstehen von authentischen Gebrauchstexten (z.B.: Fahrpläne, Prospekte)
